Joe Grilli's Tasting Note

Bouquet: Light, fresh passionfruit and citrus notes.

Palate: The mouthwateringly lively, exuberantly fruity palate with juicy passionfruit, melon and citrus flavours is the taste of summer all year round.

Vineyard Region

The Adelaide Plains are just 10 meters above sea level and benefit from cooling maritime breezes (you can see the ocean from our winery). The sunny dry climate and sandy loam soil are perfect for growing the late-ripening Colombard variety.

Vintage Conditions

An unusually mild and wet summer has given the Primo Estate Colombard delicate aromatics and lovely balance. The fruit is picked in separate parcels across a spectrum of beaume levels to achieve the perfect balance between tropical aromatic fruit flavours and crisp grape acidity.

Winemaking

A long cool fermentation in stainless steel followed by blending and early bottling to preserve delicate fruit flavours and freshness.
